

2019 FAIRPORT HARBOR SUMMER BRIDGE PROGRAM

The 2019 Fairport Summer Bridge Camp will be taking place Monday through Thursday, July 29th – August 1st, and August 5th – August 8th, with the Cedar Point finale taking place on August 12th.

This summer program is **FREE** for all Fairport students going into 6th grade!!!

In addition to multiple team-building activities, STEAM projects, and opportunities to get more comfortable and familiar with the transition to the high school building (such as walking through students' specific schedules and mastering the art of locker combinations), students will have the opportunity to:

- Go canoeing, power boating, kayaking, sailing, and swimming with the guidance of the Lake Metroparks!
- Visit the Great Lakes Science Center, tour the Steamship William G. Mather, and view an OmniMax movie!
- Go on a riverwalk at the South Chagrin Reservation to discover and learn about rocks, minerals, soil, and all of the natural beauty this park has to offer!
- **Go on an all day trip to the #1 amusement park in the world - Cedar Point!**

Each and every day will be interactive and stimulating! We hope that you are able to join us for this unique and exciting program! Students are not required to attend every day; however, to be eligible to join us on our trip to Cedar Point, students will need to attend 6 of the 8 days (including the first day, July 29th) during the two week program.

Lunch will be provided the first day of the program, but please be sure to bring a lunch, snack, and drinks with you all other days.

Please wear tennis shoes or water shoes every day (no flip-flops), follow the Fairport Harbor schools dress code, and make sure to bring your own sun screen, as non may be provided.

Hours of operation:

The program (with the exception of the Cedar Point Trip) will begin each day at 8:45 am. On days when we stay in Fairport the program will conclude at 3pm. On the days we travel to the Great Lakes Science Center and South Chagrin Reservation, the program will conclude at 5 pm. On the day of the Cedar Point trip, students must arrive by 8 am, and we will return at 9 pm. All students will receive an official camp brochure in the mail with the specific times for each day by the end of June.

Each day students will arrive at and be dismissed from the Vine Street/Board Office entrance of the High school at the times posted in the 'Daily Activities' section.

*The enclosed emergency medical forms and permission slips **MUST** be completed before participation in the program is allowed. This information must be returned to your teacher as soon as possible, to ensure proper staffing/chaperone needs.*
