Dear Parent or Guardian,

College Credit Plus allows Ohio students to earn college and high school credits at the same time by taking college courses from community colleges or universities. The CCP program allows eligible students in grades 7-12 to enroll in a state-assisted college, university, or any non-profit institution for the purpose of enhancing students' career readiness and postsecondary success.

Each year Fairport Harding High School hosts an informational meeting about the College Credit Plus program. This year the meeting will be held via zoom on **March 16, 2023 at 6:00** along with advisors from Lakeland Community College and Lake Erie College. This meeting is strongly recommended for students who intend to participate in CCP during the 2023-24 academic year.
