Dear Fairport Families,

I am sending this correspondence in an effort to give parents as much advance notice as possible. Although we are making every effort to keep Fairport Harbor Schools open, COVID-19 infections and hospitalizations continue to increase. I will be meeting with the Health Commissioner Monday morning to assess the relevant data. There is a strong possibility that at that time the Lake County Health Department will recommend that schools work in a remote setting the week of January 3-7, 2022, to allow for COVID-19 symptom monitoring. If numbers continue to increase or such a recommendation is given, Fairport Harbor Schools will be reverting to remote instruction from January 3-7, 2022. If the situation develops as anticipated, you will receive official notification Monday morning and the following actions will ensue:

All In-Person students will transition to Remote Learning on January 4-7, 2022. We hope that this will keep infected students and staff at home to start the calendar year. We anticipate In-Person classes to resume on Monday, January 10, 2022.

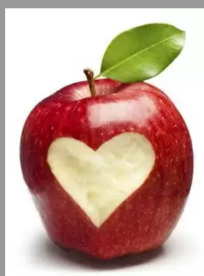
Virtual Students (Apex or Breakwater) will have no schedule changes.

Attendance- all students will have positive attendance during the duration of this Remote Learning period. There will not be any additional steps needed to track attendance during this time. Teachers will communicate their curriculum schedule for your student(s) with you.

Special Education

Your student's well-being and the continuity of their education is our top priority. We understand that an interruption of services for our students with special needs can be particularly detrimental and want to support you in every way possible during this difficult time. Please review the below information. While options for distance learning will never replace in-person contact with your intervention specialist, counselor, or teacher, we understand that at this time, that is not possible. Teachers will be providing distance learning opportunities to students until school resumes. Should this break from school continue longer than three weeks, further information will be communicated to parents.

Auburn Career Center will still be open for in-person classes, and no changes will be made for those students. Painesville City Schools will continue to transport Fairport Students to Auburn Career Center at the same time scheduled.
