COVID-19 Guidelines and Recommendations



WELCOME BACK TO SCHOOL!

IN-PERSON LEARNING

Fairport Harbor Exempted Village Schools (FHEVS), in conjunction with the Lake County General Health Department (LCGHD), aims to support in-person learning while maintaining a safe school environment. At this time, FHEVS and LCGHD, do not recommend universal masking in schools.

MASKING

FHEVS does not require masking in schools. FHEVS respects the decision-making autonomy of families and affirms each family's right to make its own decisions regarding their child's health and masking. If your child is sick/ill, they should remain home until well.

QUARANTINE

If someone is exposed to COVID-19 in any setting (e.g. work, school, household, or community), they can continue to remain in the classroom if they are feeling well and symptom-free.

ISOLATION

If someone tests positive for COVID-19, they should stay home for 5 days from when their symptoms started or 5 days from their test date if they had no symptoms. They can return to school after 5 days, provided they have been fever free for the past 24 hours (without the use of fever-reducing medication), and their symptoms are improving. They should wear a mask for the next 5 days.



EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Masking is not recommended when participating in extracurricular activities.
